Creative	Imagine you are a mountain explorer, for example, Edmund Hilary, Alison Hargreaves, Ben Fogle. Think about your time on the mountain—the conditions, the wildlife and the problems you encounter. You could present this as diary, vlog, interview or any other way you can think of.	Find out about food rationing during WW2. Research a wartime recipe and make it. Take photos of your meal.	Create a piece of artwork linked to the theme "Being me in my world". 	You have been learning the irregular verbs 'etre' and 'avoir' - create a way of helping you to remember them—it could be a rap, a song or a poster...	Learn a song from a 20 th century musical, either singing or on your chosen instrument. Record your work.	Make a model atom. You can use any materials you can get hold of.
