#### Key details to be prepared for your daughter's/son's race:

- Make sure your child has eaten a good breakfast/snack by 2 hours before their race start time. Also bring a snack to replace energy after their race.
- Children must wear their PE kit (white polo shirt, blue shorts, socks and running trainers). Spikes are allowed for Year 5 pupils upwards, but are not compulsory. Running trainers or trail shoes are more than sufficient.
- You child will be given a specific race number by LGJS staff on the day. Message from organiser: **Please bring 4 safety pins for your child to attach their race number to their PE shirt.** PLEASE KEEP THIS NUMBER they are to last for the season all 3 league races! They're fairly expensive and are tough and pre-drilled to make sure they are easy to fix.
