Many thanks to Mrs Ewington and Mrs Strong, as well as to the pupils and other staff who contributed to this. Towards the end of last term, we hosted Diana Award Anti-bullying training <https://diana-award.org.uk> for regional secondary and primary schools, and this included the training of our own groups of new volunteer ambassadors. We are all committed to creating a safe and caring community where we are kind to each other and will not tolerate bullying.




