Important general reminders

Early Morning Club

As always, there is a high demand for our EYFS (Kinders and Receptions classes) early morning drop off (8.00am - 8.15am) provision. Places are limited to 16 and are allocated on a first come, first served basis and we kindly request that you only use the service when you need to make a rapid exit from the car park. We would also request that parents directly hand over their own child to the early morning supervisors and do not hand over the children of others alongside their own child.

Lateness

Students should arrive at school ready to go to their classrooms at **8.15am** via the playground door entrance. Class registration closes at 8.30am promptly, when a buzzer will sound. If your child arrives after 8.30am then they must **sign in** at the Reception desk to ensure that they are added to class registers.

Absences

Please log onto 'My School Portal' to report absences, this is a quick and easy way to inform us of a child's absence and also request any time off for appointments or exceptional time needed off requests.

Please be aware that school communications are sent to parents via **My School Portal**. Information sometimes requires a response; It is important that prompt action is taken with some communication and additional consent forms.
